- No. 3 Phillips head screwdriver
- Socket 7mm (or wrench)
- One thumb and adjacent finger

### **About This Guide**

This Install Guide documents the installation process on a 2011 Audi S4. There may be minor differences in the engine bay of other 3.0T (supercharged) vehicles, depending on specific vehicle, market, options, etc.

### **Getting Started**

• Ensure you have all parts and tools required for installation by reading the complete Install Guide.

Step 1

Open Hood





Step 2

Remove rear engine cover



### Step 3

Using a No. 3 Phillips Head screwdriver, remove one of the stock plastic bleeder screws. Be careful not to break the head off, as old screws tend to be brittle.

If the Phillips head is stripped, you can heat up the end of the screwdriver with a torch and melt it into the head of the screw, holding it in place until it cools, thus reforming the "cross".

As long as the coolant reservoir cap is tight, you will lose minimal coolant during this procedure.





# Step 4

Install the 034Motorsport Billet S/C Bleeder Screw.
Using a 7mm socket or wrench, torque to **3NM maximum**. **DO NOT OVER TORQUE!** 



# Step 5

Repeat Steps 3 & 4 for the other screw.

Step 6

Reinstall cover that was removed in Step 2.



Step 7

Close hood.
